

NEW WATER RATES TAKE EFFECT THIS MONTH

New water and sewer rates are in effect on the bill you received this month. The minimum user will see an increase of \$2.30. Users over the 1000 gallon minimum will see an increase of \$0.50 per 1000 gallons. So if you use 5,000 gallons, you will see an increase of \$4.30.
